Intercessions for Life

Example adaptations of intercessions for use during COVID-19 (and beyond)

- Share with your pastor for use during live-streamed Masses.
- Include one intention each week in parish emails and/or text messages.
- Post one a week on your parish website.
- Send to members of your parish prayer ministry group and your parish pro-life ministry group, asking them to pray for the weekly intercessions.
- Include the weekly intercession in the parish bulletin.


