CHRISTIAN-JEWISH RELATIONS WORKSHOP SET FOR OCTOBER

WASHINGTON--Theme of the 6th National Workshop on Christian-Jewish Relations, scheduled for October 26-29 in Milwaukee, is "In the Image of God: The Challenge of Diversity."

Conducted at approximately 18-month intervals, the workshops are sponsored by the Secretariat for Catholic-Jewish Relations of the National Conference of Catholic Bishops (NCCB), the Office of Christian-Jewish Relations of the National Council of Churches, and the Committee on Interreligious Affairs of the Synagogue Council of America.

Members and staff of the Catholic bishops' conference who will address the session include Archbishop Rembert G.

Weakland, O.S.B., of Milwaukee, who will deliver the keynote address; Auxiliary Bishop Richard J. Sklba of Milwaukee;
