Instructions: To apply for financial assistance to attend CSMG 2020 through the Diversity Outreach Initiative, please complete the following steps. **Diversity Scholarship Application EXTENDED deadline is November 8, 2019.**

- 1) Fill out all of the information on this application and sign it.
- 2) Have a copy of our *Recommendation Form* filled out and signed by one of the following people:
 - A Diocesan Director for Social Action/Social Ministry/Peace & Justice/Justice & Life/Disability/Cultural Concerns (best for applicants who work/volunteer in parishes or dioceses).
 - A CSMG committee member from one of our collaborating organizations (for applicants who work/volunteer with one of the organizations – list atwww.catholicsocialministrygathering.org).
 - The CSMG Young Leaders Initiative coordinator at your college/university or a pastoral staff at your college/university Newman's Center (for college/university students who also qualify for and need assistance from the Diversity Outreach Initiative).

Scholarship Available for CSMG 2020: Limited number of registration and hotel scholarships will be awarded. Registration includes conference fee for CSMG core (the afternoon of Saturday, January 25th through Tuesday, January 28th) and does not include pre-CSMG meetings. Hotel includes three nights (nights of Saturday, January 25th; Sunday, January 26th; and, Monday, January 27th) at the Omni Shoreham Hotel, 2500 Calvert Street, NW, Washington, DC 20008. Participants shall be responsible for all incidental costs at hotel.

CSMG Registration: Scholarship recipients are not automatically registered for CSMG. For attendees who receive a scholarship, they will receive an awardee email with registration code and are asked to register within five days after receiving the email. Do <u>not</u> register until you have received notification of acceptance.

Scholarship Criteria and Considerations: (Applicant may not meet each of the following points but know that these are the criteria the Diversity Committee considers.)

- **Diversity:** Leaders and potential leaders from under-represented ethnic, cultural and disability communities who are also active in Catholic institutions, parishes, schools, and social service agencies.
- **Geographic Diversity:** We welcome applicants from a variety of geographical settings. We particularly encourage participation from rural and mission dioceses. Applicants must live 100 miles or more from Washington DC for hotel scholarship.
- Prior Participation: CSMG participants are normally limited to no more than three consecutive years of scholarship assistance through the Diversity Outreach Initiative. Returning applicants will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.
- Travel Confirmation: Applicants selected for scholarship must be able to provide documentation of
 confirmed travel arrangements by close of business Dec. 30, 2019. Scholarship will be revoked from
 participants who have not provided confirmation of travel by COB 12/30/19 and may be awarded to
 other applicants.
