STRENGTHENING THE CHURCH AT HOME

Dear Diocesan Director,

When your diocese supports the Catholic Home Missions Appeal, the faith in the United States grows stronger. Home missions dioceses are those dioceses that face fragile financial situations, vast distances, or difficult terrain that significantly impacts their ability to offer the most basic pastoral programs to the faithful. For example, in the woods of northwestern Minnesota at the edge of the Great Plains, the Diocese of Crookston serves a sparsely populated area where harsh winter weather impedes travel and where poverty affects many, especially on the two Native American reservations located there. At the Red Lake Nation reservation, poverty, crime, racial conflict, and substance abuse all contribute to an average life expectancy of 46 years. In these surroundings, the diocesan elementary school is crucial to this vulnerable community. The community relies on it so heavily that it must turn away children because of capacity enrollment.

Your support to the Catholic Home Missions Appeal helps Catholic schools such as the one at Red Lake provide a strong education to the neediest children. Because of your contributions, the diocese can strengthen the curriculum, lower fees, and help all its schools achieve accreditation to ensure students continue to receive a quality education informed by our faith. Your generosity provides vulnerable children with the tools they need to live their faith and build their futures.
