Reflection

In the book of Tobit, Tobiah and Sarah pray together on their wedding night for mercy and protection. In closing, Tobiah prays, "Now, not with lust, but with fidelity I take this kinswoman as my wife. Send down your mercy on me and on her, and grant that we may grow old together. Bless us with children" (Tobit 8:7). These brief sentences illustrate how marital love is lived fully when lived faithfully according to the marriage vows and loving in all circumstances no matter what life may bring.

This passage from Tobit also highlights the importance of a marriage built on prayer and faith in God. It is through a relationship with God that couples can learn to look beyond their own convenience and desires to the good of the other person. Inviting God in, building a marriage on faith, helps couples live in fidelity to each other and their vows.
