RELIGIOUS LIBERTY VIDEO DISCUSSION

Small community gatherings are a great, simple way to build the life of our Church. They are also important for a healthy civil society. Here are some ideas for kick starting a small-group conversation about religious freedom.

- Gather a group. Existing parish groups – such as RCIA, social action committees, or adult education – can incorporate a video viewing into their activities. Or, a small group of friends might want to gather for refreshments.
- Choose a place and time. Allow about an hour.
- Pick a moderator. The moderator need not be an expert, just a facilitator.
- Watch the ten-minute *Dignitatis Humanae* video on religious freedom.
- Discuss. Put those smartphones away! Conversation starters can help get the ball rolling.
