Children need to feel safe at home, school, and in the community.

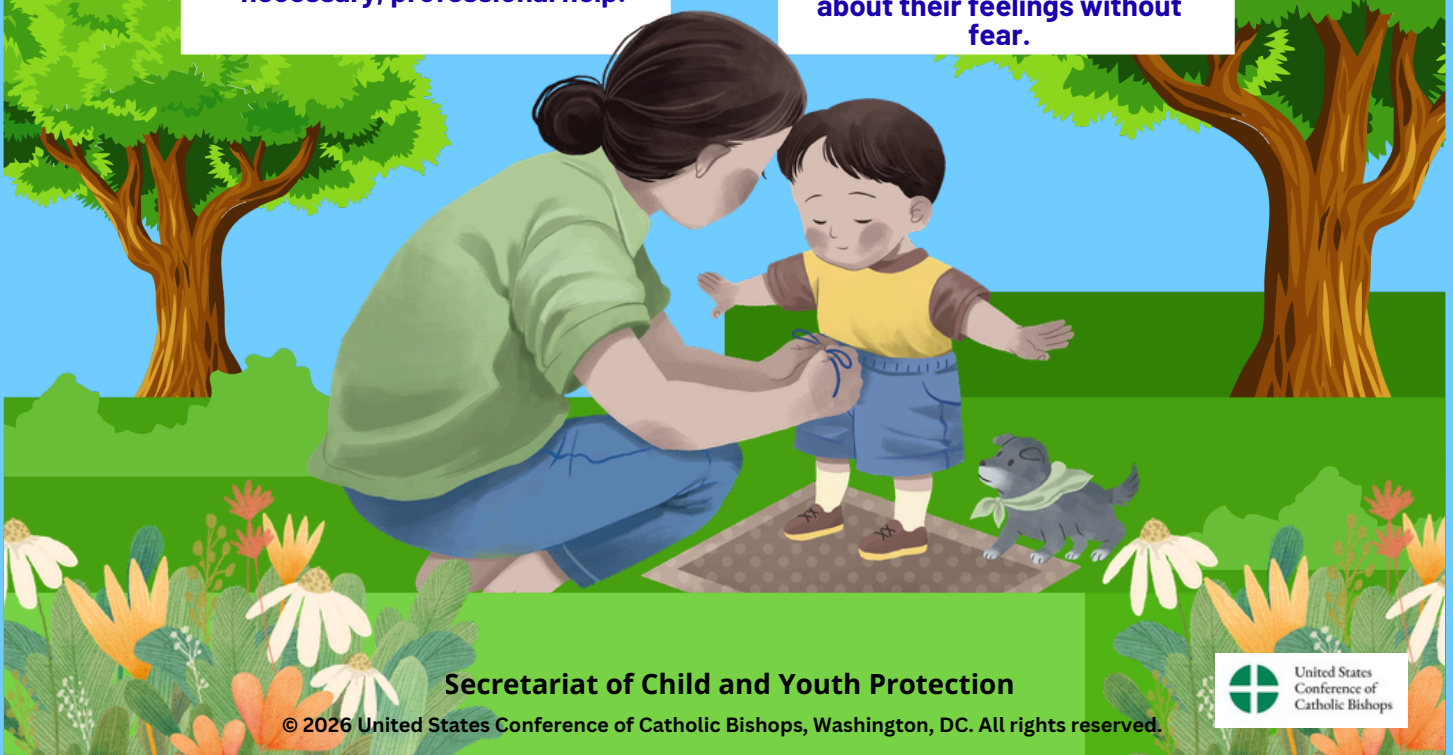
Listen to their stories and meet their emotional needs.
