Most orders are shipped via United Parcel Service (UPS) or United States Postal Service (USPS) and are delivered in 8-10 business days after receipt of order. Orders addressed to post office boxes are sent via the USPS. Rush delivery service may be arranged at the time an order is placed for an additional charge.

International Orders

Payment may be by check or money order. The customer will receive a separate invoice for the shipping and handling charges.

Paid by Credit Card or Billed

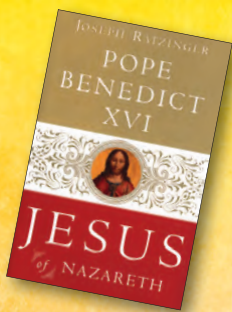
