During a time of housing shortage in the late 1980s in southern New Mexico, developers preyed on low-wage migrants and farmworkers. For very little down and low monthly payments, the migrants and farmworkers were "sold" small plots of land in unincorporated rural areas illegally. But deeds of ownership were not awarded and buyers often did not know that the illegal subdivisions, called <i>colonias</i> , would not be serviced by the state or city and had no access to clean water, plumbing, gas, sewage, solid waste disposal, paved roads and other basic services. The lack of clean water and sewage disposal caused environmental and health problems such as: hepatitis, gastrointestinal infections and other water borne diseases. With few possibilities for economic development and little access to educational opportunity, the future of the <i>colonias</i> looked bleak.
