



- The Rise Up is a new scheme of Catecheses after the request made by the Pope Francis in order to listen to the youth;
- We want to build a "new civilization of love" as the Pope John Paul II aimed when created WYD;
- The Rise Up will be organized using a sinodal methodology;




Located in the north of Parque das Nações, extending through the municipality of Loures



Close to the city center, with easy access; Space requalification; Legacy to the cities (Lisbon and Loures) after WYD







A macro group must be divided into subgroups of a max of 150. This option allows to choose different packages per subgroup



- 2. On the arrival day, dinner is included. Check out only includes breakfast. Breakfast is only included for packages with accommodation.










