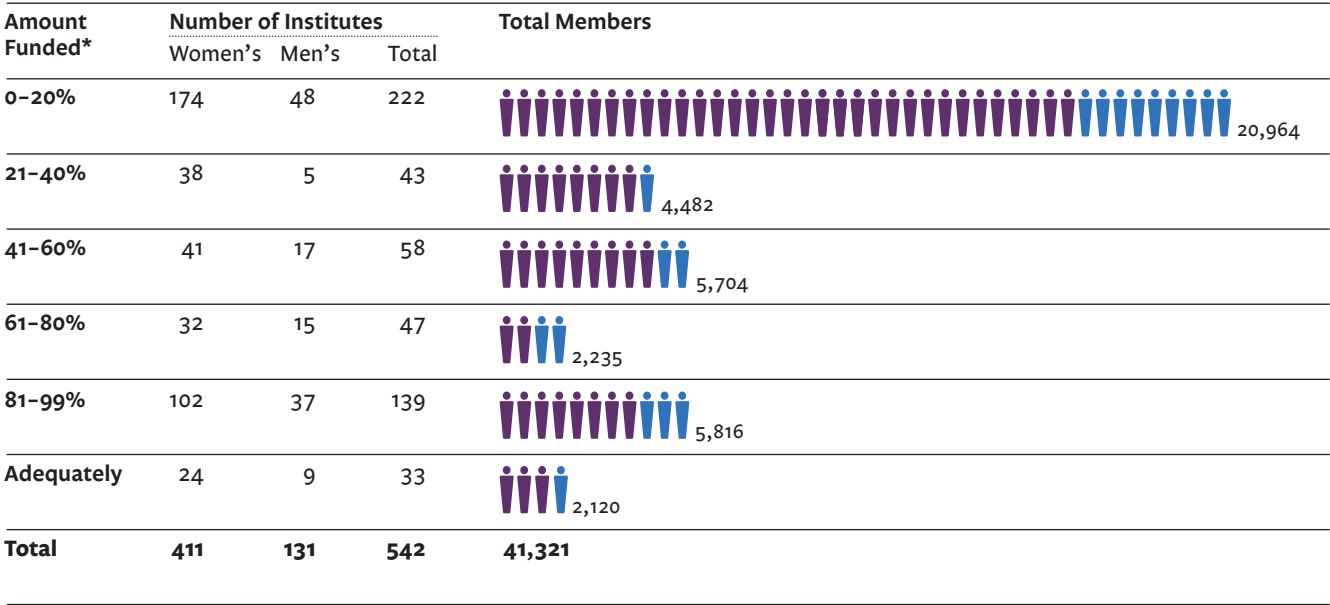




Retirement Funding Status and Membership of 542 Participating Religious Institutes

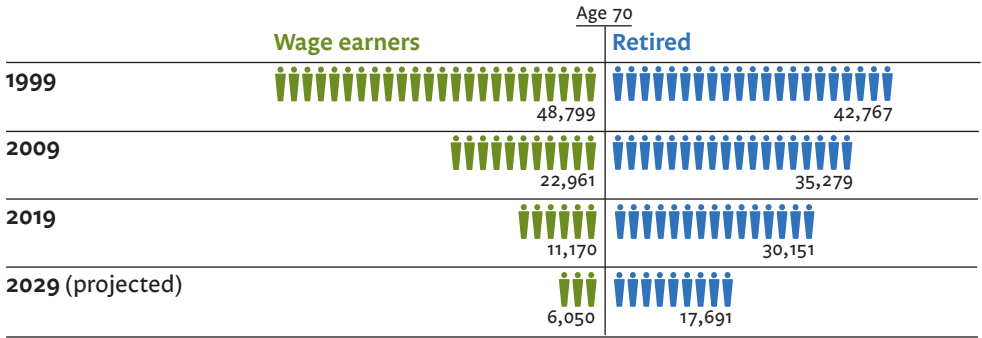

Membership Status, NRRO Participating Religious Institutes



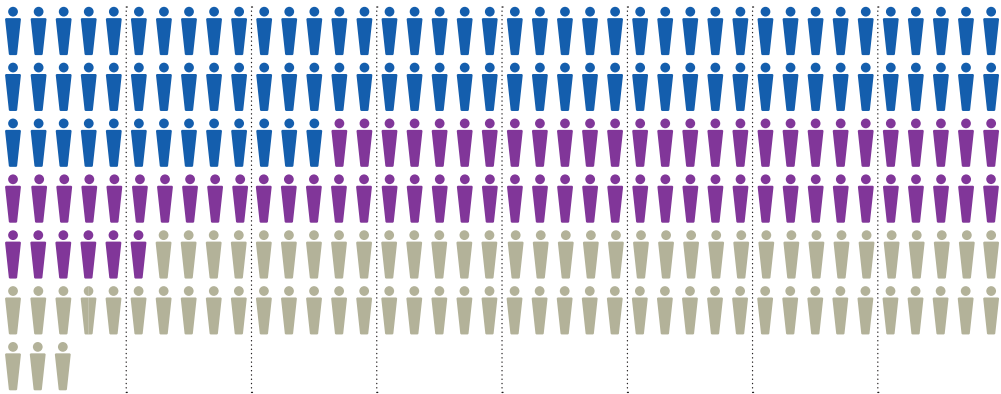

There are 60,649* Catholic sisters, brothers, and religious order priests in the United States. More than 41,000 of these belong to religious communities that receive financial assistance and/or support and services made possible by the Retirement Fund for Religious.

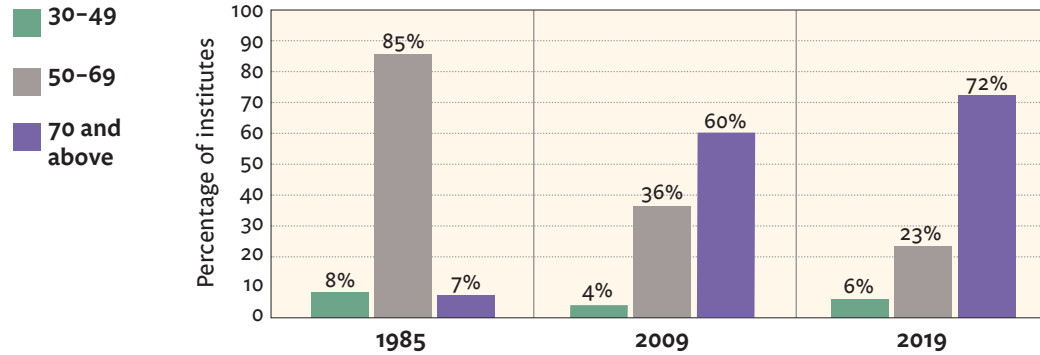

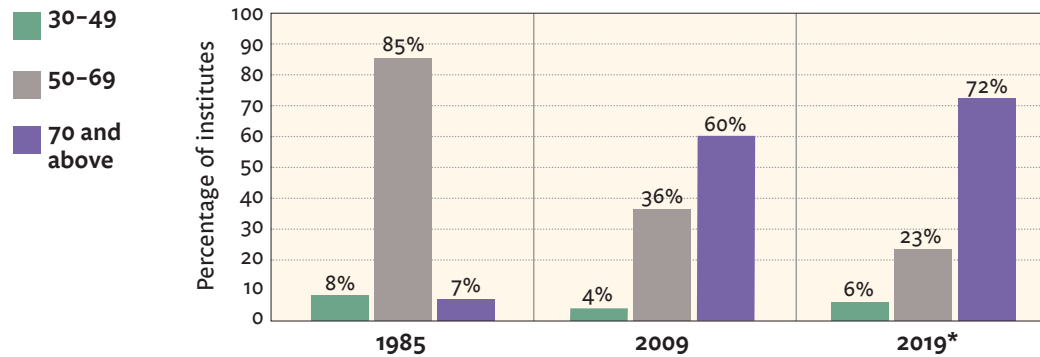
Median Age in Participating Religious Institutes

Median Age in Participating Religious Institutes

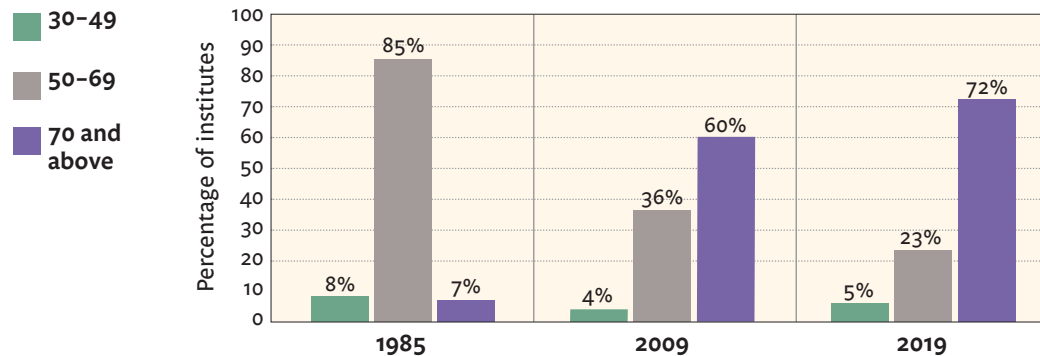

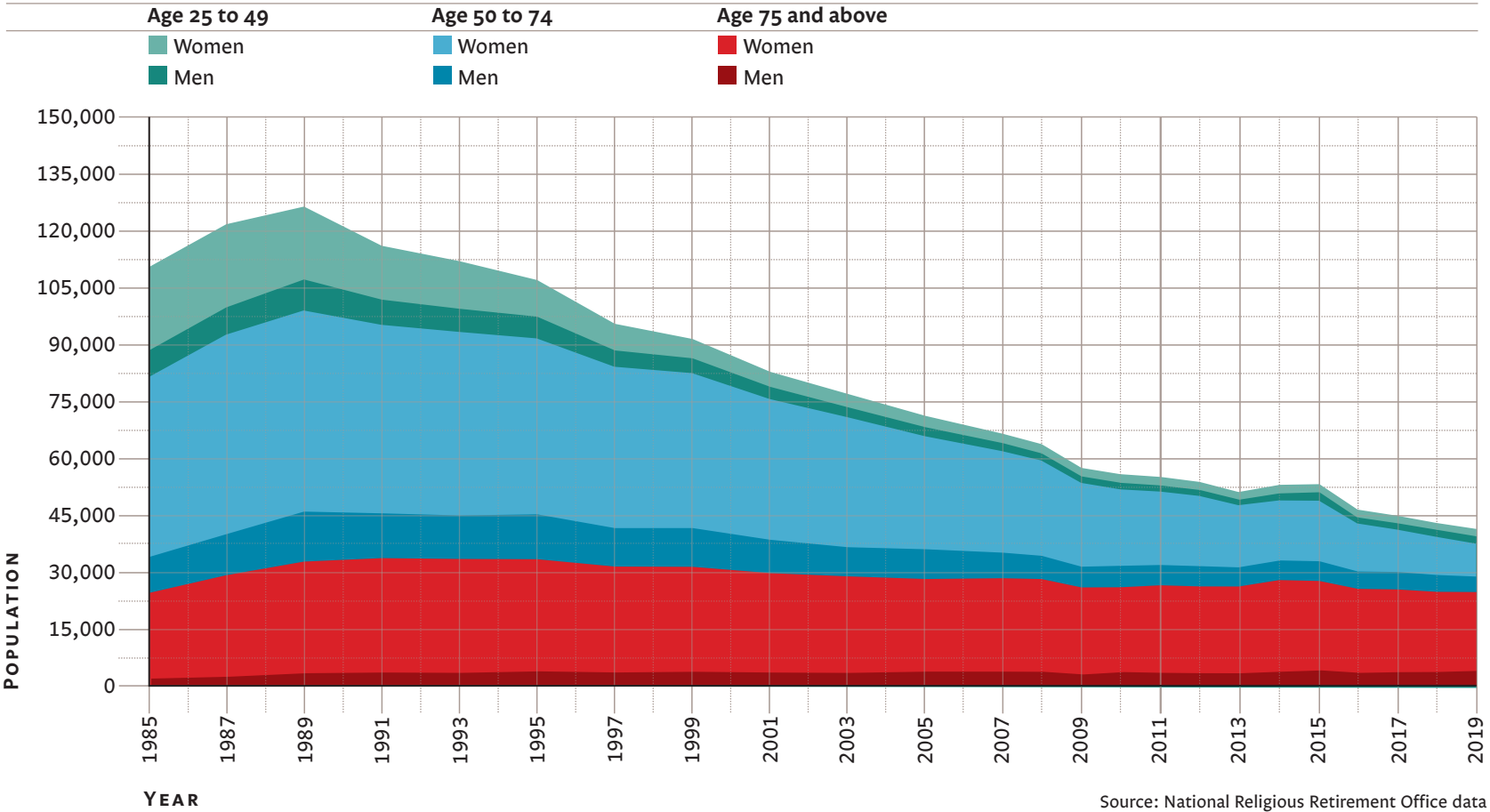

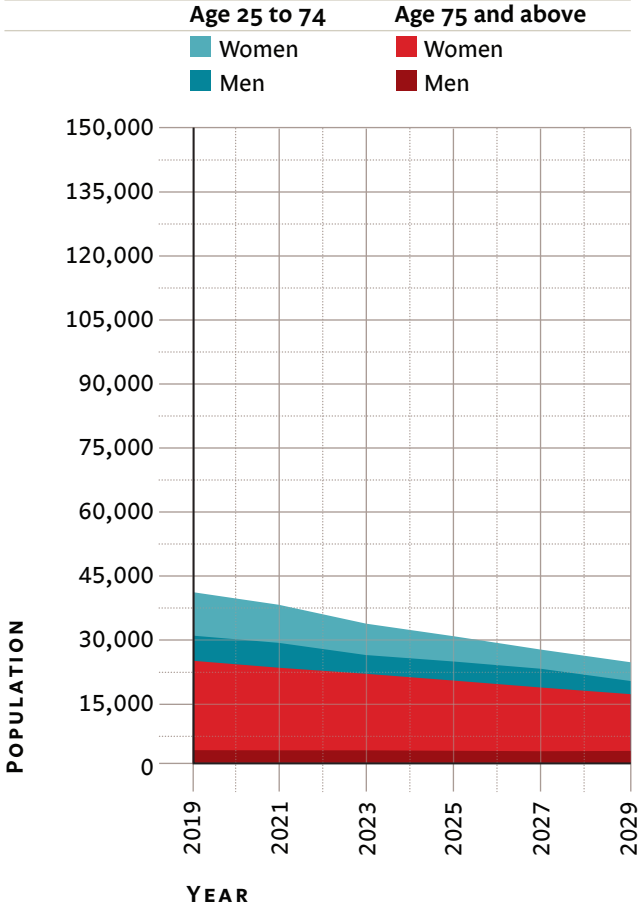
Median Age in Participating Religious Institutes
