Pocket Guide

- Safeguard your passport and identity documents when traveling. Foreigners who arrive in Portugal without a valid passport will not be permitted to enter and will be returned to their point of origin.
- Do not leave valuables in rental cars, especially those with stickers identifying the vehicle as a rental car. Tourists are frequent victims of petty crime/car break-ins.
- Avoid using ATM in isolated or poorly lit areas.
- Illicit drug transactions increase at night, and travelers are often approached by drug dealers in the downtown area of Lisbon, beware of these incidents
- Keep doors and windows of private rentals locked at all times, taking extra care if easily accessed from the street or other places
