World Council of Churches (WCC) General Secretary, the Rev. Dr. Olav Fykse Tveit met with Egypt's Grand Mufti Shawki Ibrahim Abdel-Karim in Cairo at the office of Dar Al-Itfa Al-Misriyya to discuss the promotion of peaceful relations amongst Christians and Muslims. Both stressed the sense of common roots of the centuries-long coexistence between Christians and Muslims in Egypt:

"*We are a family,*" said the Grand Mufti. "*The powers of sowing seeds of divisions should be curtailed.*" Dr. Tveit echoed his sentiment, "*We share a vision of peaceful relations among communities and hope for a common future.*"


(April 17, 2013) Muslim organizations condemned Boston terrorist activity in solidarity with victims of Boston bombings .
