



Template to Develop a Pastoral Plan for Hispanic/Latino Ministry

PART 1: MESSAGE FROM THE BISHOP, PASTOR, HEAD OF ORGANIZATION OR INSTITUTION

Part 1 should include a message from the bishop, pastor or head of the organization/institution acknowledging and expressing gratitude for the Hispanic/Latino people in their region, dioceses, parishes, or organizations/institutions and recognize the valuable contributions Hispanics/Latinos bring to the Church and society. *Refer to Part I of the National Pastoral Plan for ideas. Recommended length 1-2 pages.*

PART 2: MISSION AND VISION FOR HISPANIC/LATINO MINISTRY

Part 2 should include a mission and vision for Hispanic/Latino ministry that highlights the need to be more intentional about Hispanic/Latino ministry. You can incorporate the National Pastoral Guidelines to implement the vision at the local level in your region, diocese, parish, or Catholic organization/institution. Remember to consider your local reality. *Refer to Part II of the Plan. Recommended length: 1-2 pages.*

Mission for Hispanic/Latino Ministry

A mission is a concise and inspiring declaration that outlines who the group/organization is, the purpose of the organization, and what the ministry seeks to accomplish.

Vision Statement for Hispanic/Latino Ministry

A vision statement is a concise and inspiring declaration that outlines the desired future state or direction for Hispanic/Latino ministry. It describes the long-term goals, aspirations, and values that guide and shape the work of the ministry.

PART 3: CONSIDERATIONS FOR DIOCESES, PARISHES, REGIONS AND CATHOLIC ORGANIZATIONS AND INSTITUTIONS

Part 3 should include important considerations for your diocese, parish, region or Catholic organization/institution regarding the organization, structure, and resources of Hispanic/Latino ministry in the future. *Dioceses, parishes, and regions should refer to Part III of the Plan, while Catholic organizations and institutions should develop their own plans based on their specific realities. Recommended length: 2-5 pages.*

PART 4: PASTORAL PRIORITIES

Considering your reality, what changes or adaptations to your pastoral priorities for your region, diocese, parish, Catholic organization, or institution need to be included? Identify objectives and pastoral approaches based on the 10 priorities presented in the National Plan. If applicable, revisit pastoral priorities established during the V Encuentro process and ensure to incorporate/adapt them in this part of the plan. *Refer to Part IV for ideas, and make sure to consider your own situation by developing your own priorities or adapting those in the National Plan. Recommended length: 4-7 pages.*

To develop this section:

- List your top priorities for Hispanic/Latino ministry
- For each priority
 - o develop an introductory paragraph.
 - \circ write an objective.
 - o list your pastoral approaches.

PART 5: PROJECTS AND INITIATIVES

Part 5 should include specific projects/initiatives with an objective set forth by the region, diocese, parish, or Catholic organization/institution. *Refer to Part V of the Plan for examples. Recommended length: 5-10 pages.*

Consider using the following format.

- List your projects and initiatives. Write the objective of each project or initiative. Projects/initiatives can be existing or new.
- Complete the information in the table for each project/initiative.
