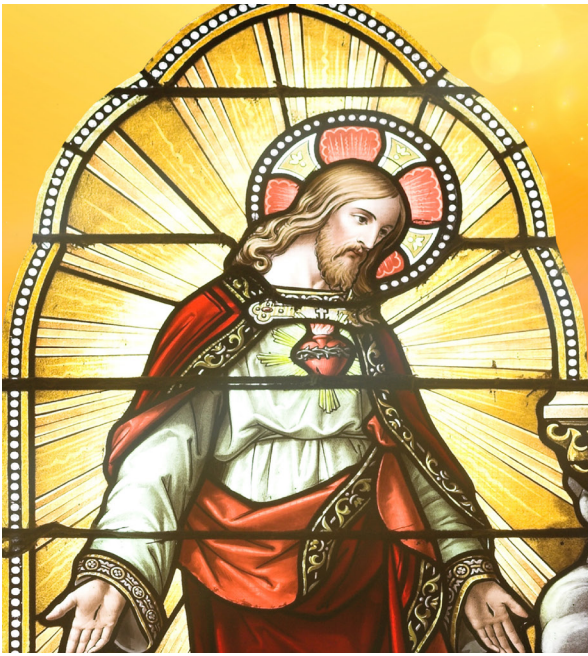

Shreveport Martyrs Vote

Advancement on the local level the cause of the beatification and canonization of the five Shreveport Martyrs, missionary priests who heroically ministered to victims of an 1873 yellow fever epidemic in Shreveport, LA.

National Eucharistic Revival Initiative and National Eucharistic Congress
