In June 2019, Fr. Pepe took his oath as a naturalized United States citizen and celebrated his fourth anniversary as a priest. First as a religious worker on a visa, and now as a U.S. citizen, Fr. Pepe is living his vocation by ministering to Latino communities in their own language. "It is a great gift to be able to listen to people in a way that makes them feel understood," he says.
