
ORDER OF RELIGIOUS PROFESSION OF WOMEN THE RITE OF PERPETUAL PROFESSION WITHIN MASS

Bestowal of the Insignia of Profession (Chapter VIII, no. 237)



- ² My heart overflows with noble *words*. †

 To the king I address the song I **have** made, *

 my tongue as nimble as the *pen of* **a** scribe.
- ³ You are the most handsome of the sons of *men*, † and graciousness is poured out upon **your** lips, * for God has blessed *you fore*vermore. R.
- ⁴ Gird your sword upon your thigh, O **might**y one, * with your splendor *and your* **ma**jesty.
- In your majesty ride on triumphant † in the cause of truth, meekness and right. * May your right hand show your wondrous deeds. R.
- ⁶ Your arrows are sharp—peoples fall be**neath** you—* in the heart of the *foes of* **the** king.
- ⁷ Your throne, O God, shall endure forev*er*. †
 A scepter of justice is the scepter of your **king**dom. *
- Your love is for uprightness; your hatred for **e**vil. **R**.

Therefore God, your God, has anointed *you* † with the oil of gladness above **o**ther kings: *

your robes are fragrant with aloes, *myrrh*, and **ca**ssia. R.

From the ivory palace you are gladdened with music. †

The daughters of kings are those whom you **fa**vor. * On your right stands the queen in *gold of* **O**phir. **R**.



- ¹¹ Listen, O daughter; pay heed and **give** ear: * forget your own people *and your* **fa**ther's house.
- ¹² So will the king desire your **beau**ty. *
 He is your lord, pay *homage* **to** him. **R**.
- ¹³ And the daughter of Tyre shall come **with** gifts; * the richest of the people shall *seek your* **fa**vor.
- The daughter of the king is clothed with splendor; * her robes are threaded with gold. R.
- ¹⁵ In fine clothing she is led to **the** king; * behind her are her maiden compan*ions*, *brought* **to** you.
- They are escorted amid gladness and joy; * they pass within the palace of the king. R.
- ¹⁷ Sons will be yours to succeed your **fa**thers; * you will make them rulers o*ver all* **the** earth.
- ¹⁸ I will make your name forever remembered. *
 Thus the peoples will praise you from age to age. R.
