#### October 23<sup>rd</sup>

For women and men suffering after abortion: May the Church's abortion healing ministry, Project Rachel, help them find peace and healing through Christ's endless mercy; We pray to the Lord: **Thirtieth Sunday** in Ordinary Time

## October 30th

For those nearing the end of life: May they receive care that respects their dignity and protects their lives as they place their hope in the promise of eternal life; We pray to the Lord: Thirty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time


